The BC Speed Skating Academy Outreach Tour will be coming North with a long track session in Fort St John on January 9th and 10th, 2016. The session will be held at the Pomeroy Sports Centre, which is also the location for the FSJ LT Interclub on January 9th. The coach for the session will be Arno Hoogveld (Calgary Olympic Oval). The tentative schedule is:

Saturday January 9th

- ~17:00 end of FSJ LT Interclub
- 17:00-19:00 dinner (individual)
- 19:00-20:30 Academy classroom session

Sunday January 10th

- 7:15-8:00 off-ice warm up and skates on
- 8:00-10:00 on-ice
- 10:00-11:00 off-ice wrap up

What is the BCSSA Academy? The Academy is a project to help prepare our 2019 Canada Winter Games age-eligible skaters for the next Games. The concept is that our skaters will have opportunities to train together to practice racing skills, passing skills and team events (relays in short track and team pursuit in long track). This is the first year of the Academy. This season, a pilot of the Academy is being offered in Richmond, BC. The Academy consists of 13 sessions that involve on-ice and off-ice training. To reach skaters outside of the Lower Mainland, there are drop-in opportunities available at the Richmond pilot. There will also be an Academy Outreach Tour visiting clubs around the province throughout the season. The hope is that the Academy will be expanded to more locations and to include both disciplines (short track and long track) in future seasons.

All skaters who are age-eligible for the 2019 Canada Winter Games are invited to attend the Academy Outreach Tour session. This includes skaters who will be between 14-18 years old as of July 1, 2018. Additionally, any skaters named to the 2015-2016 Provincial Performance Program (regardless of age) are invited.

The cost of each session is \$10/skater- note that skaters who are registered full-time for the Academy Pilot in Richmond are not required to pay the \$10. Skaters must confirm their attendance at the session by emailing their completed waiver to Chris Acton (chris.acton@speed-skating.bc.ca) by January 2nd. Lorna at the BCSSA Office will invoice skaters for the cost of the sessions after the sessions are complete. Please do not send money to Chris nor leave it with local session organizers.
