Duties

- BC Speed Skating Academy:
 - With the BC Speed Skating Technical Director, develop Academy season plan for all Stage 1 and Stage 2 LT skaters
 - Plan and deliver all Academy LT training opportunities*:
 - Academy Long Track Fall Camp #1 September 13-15, 2019
 - Academy Long Track Fall Camp #2 October 4-6, 2019
 - Academy Sunday @ BC Cup LT January 12, 2020
 - Opportunity for extension (to be confirmed): lead Academy LT training opportunities during the spring/summer of 2020
- Team BCSSA: lead Team BCSSA @ Canadian Age Class LT Championship
- Skater Monitoring:
 - With the BC Speed Skating Technical Director, monitor performances (testing and competition results) of provincial-level LT skaters in-season
 - Liaise with Academy LT skaters' club coaches
- Sport Development: assist in the development of the sport across the province

- Recent competition coaching experience at regional/national level competitions
