- 1. Cannot perform the task on own. Requires physical assistance to prevent critical mistakes.
- 2. Requires frequent verbal assistance to prevent critical mistakes.
- 3. Consistently performs the task to an acceptable level, on his her own, without making critical mistakes. Practice will improve performance. May require occasional verbal assistance to analyze specific problems or situations, but remains able to deal with these same situations without making unacceptable mistakes. Level 3 is the minimum level required of any chief official.
- 4. Performs the task confidently and effectively at all times. Quality of the performance will improve with practice/experience, without requiring outside verbal or other assistance. This is the terminal level required in all tasks.
- 5. Flawless performance. The ideal official under the circumstances. The incidence of level 5 performance should increase as one progresses in grade, but it is unreasonable to expect this level of performance continuously and in all tasks from an official
