

2021-2022 GenBC Nomination

Historically

- Nomination occurs at the completion of the season annually
- Nomination is based on the skater's age and results as of the season that has just been completed (e.g. 2020-2021 GenBC Nomination was based on the 2019-2020 season)
- "Nomination" has historically been done automatically based on results

2021-2022 GenBC Nomination

- Nomination will be an active, <u>online nomination form</u> completed by the skater's primary coach
- Criteria is based on the current (2020-2021) season
- Nomination forms due April 1, 2021
- BC Speed Skating will review nominations and offer positions to skaters in May 2021



BCASPEED SKATING GenBC

2021-2022 GenBC Nomination Form

GenBC-eligible skaters should request that their primary coach (club coach or training centre coach) completes this form. The skater is responsible for follow-up with their primary coach to ensure the form is completed and submitted by the deadline of April 1st, 2021.

It is recommended that the skater, their parent/guardian, and the coach collaborate to complete the form; examples:

- 1. Collaboratively complete the form using screen-share on a video call
- 2. Have the skater complete a hard copy of the form in advance for reference as the coach completes the online (official) nomination form
- 3. Discuss the questions together on a video call, etc.

The first section pertains to the coach who is submitting the form.
